




EPA-UNEPSA is the only European society invited to publish a monthly editorial section in a prestigious U.S. scientific journal, the "Journal of Pediatrics" (www.jpeds.com), where EPA-UNEPSA's commentaries and editorials, written by highly regarded experts, have become an important scientific platform, providing influential overviews of current hot topics in pediatrics.

EPA-UNEPSA is also active in the specific area of nutrition as a key partner in the European Union's Safe Food For Infants (SAFFI) project, as part of a consortium of 20 public and industrial partners led by the French government agency for food, nutrition, and agriculture (INRAE) (https://www.saffi.eu). This significant program, developed in collaboration with governmental, academic, and private institutions, is funded by an EU Horizon 2020 research and innovation grant. It aims to provide safe food for children by developing an efficient trans-European food quality monitoring system throughout the entire food production chain.

For 50 years, EPA-UNEPSA has worked relentlessly to foster scientific cooperation between not-for-profit National Pediatric Societies and Associations in Europe, as well as among European pediatricians working in primary, secondary, and tertiary pediatric care. The goal is to promote child health and comprehensive pediatric care. EPA-UNEPSA will continue in the coming years to enhance the quality of pediatric patient care in all European countries, including both EU member and non-member states, through adequate clinical research and by translating research into practice.





The historical, ancient city of Kotor, which is under the protection of UNESCO with its surroundings, is 20 minutes from Budva.


